Meeting opened at 5:35 pm after supper was served, with a presentation by Keith Weston Water Quality Specialist, NRCS State Office. Keith reviewed the Jamestown Headwaters Rapid Watershed Assessment. This is a resource inventory of a specific watershed area. There are 51 8-digit Hydrologic Unit Code's (HUC) in the state. Nine were done last year and 4-5 more will be done by October of this year. This showed about 2000 acres of impaired water bodies i.e. the Jamestown Reservoir.

The second presentation was a power point by Kim Hanson Project Leader at Arrowwood Refuge Complex. He reviewed the background and history of the refuge, the current sub-impoundment project and the buffalo carp harvesting operation.

After supper and presentations the group embarked on a tour of the Arrowwood construction project led by Kim Hanson.
